It seems from speaking to those who were at the death camp that the Saturdays have been slow. One two separate Saturdays the parking lot was almost empty. I believe that this is due to the fact that the abortionist has to be the one who does the counseling and who also will have to do the abortion. This law has been in place for sometime but was not enforced. Now that "big" brother is watching the mill is more careful.

If Colleen does the counseling on Tuesday but does not abort babies until the next Tuesday, by law this mom cannot come back for seven days. Sounds good?

A young girl's father brought his daughter and her boyfriend to have his grandchild killed. Daddy's are to protect their little girls. Maybe that grandchild was a girl?

Planned Parenthood held their "training" day for the youth. Moms, dads brought their children for the so called safe sex education. Thirty-eight youth came out into the parking lot to hold signs that say they are with planned parenthood and to chant that "these doors stay open." What they are really saying is that the doors of this death camp will stay open when they find themselves pregnant. I don't like saying an unwanted pregnancy because each pregnancy is wanted. ## NEWS ITEMS

### Catholic Priest Arrested for Going Inside Abortion Clinic to Offer Women Abortion Alternatives

Eleven people were arrested over the weekend who simultaneously entered abortion centers to talk to women scheduled for abortions. Among them was a Catholic priest, Father Stephen Imbarrato of Priests for Life.

The pro-life defense of the unborn took place at three different clinics: Stephen Brigham's Capital Women's Service in Washington, DC, the Alexandria Women's Health Clinic in Alexandria, VA, and the Women's Center Clinic in Bloomfield Township, Michigan.

Father Imbarrato of Priests for Life joined two other pro-life advocates, Julia Haag and Joan McKee, to provide abortion alternatives inside the abortion clinic. They discovered a totally-packed waiting room — so packed that other women scheduled for abortions were forced to wait in the outside hallway outside the entrance of the abortion facility. They were able to distribute red roses to all those inside the clinic, offering words of encouragement to women to not abort their babies.

Abortion clinic staff however rounded up all the women and sequestered them behind the reception area. The pro-lifers then went out into the hallway and continued to talk to the women waiting there for their abortions.

Soon however, the women inside the abortion clinic were allowed to re-enter the waiting room area and the pro-lifers went back into the clinic to speak to them again. At that time, local police arrived and warned the pro-lifers that they were trespassing on private property. By now they had already been inside either the abortion clinic or hallway for over an hour.

The pro-lifers went back to the hallway where women scheduled for abortions were still gathered. The police officers then made a stunning decision and allowed the three pro-life advocates to stay in the hallway as long as they were not told to leave by the owner of the building. Their ability to counsel and witness to the women went on for another hour and 45 minutes before Fr. Imbarrato, Haag and McGee were placed under arrest and removed from the building.

Outside several others were praying and sidewalk counsel. They were joined by Mary Wagner who conducts her own Red Rose Rescue witness in Canada.

### **Missouri's new abortion rules could mean big costs for Planned Parenthood**

Paying for physicians to be on call at all times at local clinics could cost Planned Parenthood a pretty penny.

In late November, the health department's proposed new rules were made public, along with estimates of how much the new rules would cost private entities — such as the Springfield and Joplin clinics where Planned Parenthood hopes to offer medication abortions. Additional regulations are required because of the laws the Missouri General Assembly passed this summer in a special session called by Gov. Eric Greitens.

The health department has proposed emergency requirements for medication abortion providers to craft plans to deal with complications from the procedure. These rules appear designed to protect women from potential consequences of Missouri's new abortion laws.

Under the new laws, abortion providers and physicians without department-approved complications plans cannot offer medication abortions. Implementing these rules swiftly could allow women to obtain medication abortions instead of surgical terminations. Surgical abortions might "not be in the best interest of every patient and could put some patients at unnecessary risk," according to the department's emergency statement.

The complication-plan regulation requires abortion providers to have a physician on standby at all times. This is alarming to Planned Parenthood, due in part to its price tag.

According to a state fiscal analysis, the average annual cost to have an OB/GYN be on-call 24/7 is \$182,50

### **Alive or Dead? What the Heck Happened To This Botched Abortion Victim?**

Disturbing photos have surfaced that show a woman bound at the neck to a gurney during a medical emergency at Hartford GYN Center on October 21, 2017.

The photos, which were taken by a pro-life activist who was on the scene when the emergency occurred, depicted a woman covered completely in white sheets with a restraint strap buckled under her chin and across her neck. A sheet that covered her head appeared to be cinched at the neck.

### **UNSAFE: Ambulance Transports 12th Patient from Unaccountable Milwaukee Abortion Facility**

Affiliated Medical Services, located in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, is an independent urban abortion facility that is no stranger to medical emergencies.

According to local activist Dan Miller, since February 2010, he has counted twelve ambulances that have transported abortion

patients to local hospitals - including the most recent incident that took place on November 18, 2017.

### **California abortuaries closing**

Earlier this year, we told you of the incredible journey of the Our Lady of Guadalupe missionary image that traveled throughout the state of California. Her journey was known as Our Lady's Mission for Life. She was taken, by Teresa Marsano and Dora Lee Raras, to 141 abortion facilities in the state. At each facility, prayers and other devotional acts called upon the mother of God to close down the abortion facilities. Word reached us this week that, thus far, six of the abortion facilities during the OLG pilgrimage have closed down. Praise God!

### **Planned Parenthood closing abortion centers**

Planned Parenthood continues to close abortion centers at a pace far exceeding new facilities being opened. The latest research by STOPP shows that, in 2017 alone, Planned Parenthood closed over 30 abortion facilities while opening just a half-dozen new ones. This continued shrinking of the abortion giant is good news for communities across the United States and is lifesaving news for the babies and their mothers who will no longer be subject to the evils of Planned Parenthood at these closed facilities.

### **911: Woman Bleeding Excessively in Middle of Abortion at Connecticut Abortion Facility**

An abortion patient suffered "excessive bleeding" in the middle of an abortion procedure at Hartford GYN Center in Hartford, Connecticut, according to 911 records obtained by Operation Rescue.

A 911 call was placed by "Madeline," a Hartford GYN nurse, at 10:01 a.m. on October 21, 2017. She indicated that the patient was in the middle of a "procedure" and was bleeding heavily. The woman was sedated, and it appeared that the clinic staff were going to under sedation while they continued the abortion procedure.

### **Former Respect Life Apostolate Director Archbishop Naumann to Chair USCCB Pro-Life Committee!**

Archbishop Joseph Naumann, who served as the director of the St. Louis Respect Life Apostolate from 1985 to 1995, was recently elected to chair the Pro-Life Committee for the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops.

Archbishop Naumann is known for his strong support of St. Pope John Paul II's Culture of Life. He prioritizes pro-life issues in his teaching ministry and regularly challenges pro-abortion public policy and politicians, according to the National Catholic Register.

At the same time, the archbishop has compassion on those facing crisis pregnancies and those caught up in the culture of death.

As the Register reported, "As a young priest, he oversaw the pro-life office of the Archdiocese of St. Louis. Under his leadership, the archdiocese began the Project Rachel ministry, a post-abortion healing ministry. He also worked to support pregnancy centers and homes for mothers and children."

**EDITOR'S COMMENTS**

As I stand at the gates of hell with the cool breeze of fall I wonder what it would be like if abortion was no more. I would be able to be with my family on Saturday mornings and during the week. I would not be pleading for the life of an innocent unborn child. I would not be standing in the cold, rain, and snow. Nor the heat of the summer. Threats on my life would not exist. Babies would be alive. Some babies would be 32 years old and maybe have children of their own. Moms would be alive today because the botched abortion never happened. Dads would be playing baseball with their son, but now they regret the day that their child died.

Laws to protect the unborn would not have to be challenged after they become law. Abortionist would be delivering babies, not traveling across the country killing babies and harming moms and dads.

The sidewalk in front of this deathcamp would be empty but it would be empty because the need to stand in prayer would not be needed.

Women would be seeking help with the pregnancy not looking for an easy way out. Abortion is not the easy way out. Our mission would be to provide support and help for moms, by supporting maternity homes, aiding in the adoption process.

Just think if we rid our country of the death sentence of the unborn child how God would be pleased with our taking care of his children, our country. But instead we have not protected His children nor our country. We are in such a deep hole I am not sure that hole will ever be closed.

But that is not how God wants us to feel. He ask that we be faithful in our task to rid this country of the most horrific abuse of any human being. The unborn child.

Many years ago our state had eight abortion mills and with the commitment of churches along with the Direct Action League seven of the eight abortion mills began to close. That meant that babies lives were saved. One particular church in West County with the leadership of a dedicated woman took on the task to cover an entire week with prayer warriors. She did this every month. Before long the mill began to close on one day and then another day, and before long it was GONE. But you see this death camp housed three different abortion mills. Within a few years this place of death was no more a place of death but was auctioned off and now it is a place that will do good.

Our task here with the last abortion in the city of St. Louis can also have that result. But YOU are needed to make that possible. We are asking that you commit to taking some time each month or every other month along with your church, youth group or just your friends to come and pray and be a witness for the unborn child. In the next few weeks we will be making a call to the pro-life coordinator in your church to see if we can make this happen.

**No one should die alone.**

We will be entering the Holy Season of Christmas. We will celebrate the birth of Our Lord. Let us open up our hearts and to stand in prayer for all the unborn children of God.

We have made great strides here in Missouri but the task is not complete. I don't like leaving a task undone. But as I said before I cannot do this alone. I need your help with God as our Leader we shall end this senseless killing of His children and bring our country back to respect for all.
