50th Anniversary Legalizing Abortion

It's the 50th anniversary of a groundbreaking Colorado law that significantly loosened restrictions on legal abortions.

Before the law, Colorado - like many states - allowed abortions only if a woman's life was at stake.

In 1967, rookie Democratic state lawmaker Richard Lamm introduced the bill, which allowed abortions if the woman's physical or mental health was threatened if the unborn child might have birth defects or in cases of rape or incest. He said he thought the bill might derail his political career.

Colorado was the first U.S. state to do so - six years before the U.S. Supreme Court legalized abortion nationwide.

Missouri Gov. Eric Greitens Fighting to Stop St Louis From Becoming a “Sanctuary City for Abortion”

That the St. Louis Board of Aldermen passed an ordinance declaring St. Louis a “sanctuary city” for abortion is outrageous.

That the Missouri Senate has ground to a halt and can’t get legislation to move – including a state solution to stop St. Louis – is frightening.

Politics as usual has devolved into Republicans filibustering other Republican measures on their own Senate floor. Pro-life legislation is left waiting.

Missouri Gov. Eric Greitens

All predictions have the Missouri Senate not likely to get much legislation through before its May 12th deadline. Governor Greitens needs a budget and has said he will call as many special sessions as necessary to get that done. But he also won’t let the legislature off the hook until a solution is passed to fix the so-called anti-discrimination ‘sanctuary city for abortion’ problem out of St. Louis.

Missouri was a ground zero state in the 2016 gubernatorial elections, and Greitens, a newcomer to politics, won the Governor’s race with a strong commitment to pro-life initiatives. He’s ready to deliver... only to have the Missouri Senate devolve into inactivity. His budget would defund Planned Parenthood and provide \$6 million for alternatives to abortion centers.

Pro-life legislator Rep. Donna Lichtenegger, author of the Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act banning abortion at 20 weeks when a baby can feel pain, expressed doubts that her bill, stalled in the House like planes on a tarmac, will pass. State regulations against trafficking in fetal tissue and dignified disposal of aborted babies authored by Rep. Diane Franklin and Senator Bob Onder are also in peril. Pro-life advocates lament the gridlock and worry about the fate of women and their babies in an environment rich with clinic violations in St. Louis, horrific disposal practices, and possibly trafficking.

The idea of St. Louis as a ‘sanctuary city’ for abortion – or any other copycat city in America – is chilling. It would be a nightmare if the gridlock in the Missouri Senate would ultimately allow St. Louis’ discriminatory actions to stand, or to turn a blind eye to the pain of abortion in the womb or trafficking in the lives of unwanted babies, in the name of politics as usual.

The Missouri Senate needs to understand the gravity of its responsibilities and give Governor Greitens the tools he needs to protect women and babies and combat discriminatory attacks on pro-life businesses in St. Louis.

Missouri budget amendment would 'decimate' system of family planning clinics, providers say

Clinics that provide contraception and checkups for about 70,000 uninsured Missouri women may lose state funding next fiscal year, if they give patients information about abortion. An amendment in the state budget, expected to be finalized next week, bars the Missouri Women’s State-Funded Health Services Program from covering care by a doctor or clinic that offers abortion services, as defined by a state law for sex education. That includes those that provide abortion referrals. The provision is an expansion of a rule passed last year, which cut organi-

zations that provide abortions out of the program and cost Missouri \$8.3 million in federal funding.

“This amendment goes much farther and could actually decimate the entire family planning network,” said Michelle Trupiano, executive director of the Missouri Family Health Council. “When you start eliminating providers and restricting who can say what, at the end of the day you’re going to restrict access.”

Trupiano’s organization dispenses federal Title X funds to 71 clinics for family planning services throughout Missouri, including federally qualified health clinics and Planned Parenthood. A 2007 rule requires Title X recipients to tell pregnant women about all of their options in a neutral manner upon request. That includes prenatal care, adoption, and abortion — discussions that could force these providers out of the state’s program, Trupiano said.

“Title X providers or really any health care provider that gives information and full access of information to women would no longer be able to participate in the program,” Trupiano said. “At the end of the day that limits access for women.”

Lobbyist Sam Lee, director of the anti-abortion group Campaign Life Missouri, said the difference between counseling and referral is clear.

“I have no qualms with a counselor having a discussion with a pregnant client about her options,” Lee said. “The difference is to then go ahead and tell her, OK, if you want an abortion, here is the name, address, website, phone number of the nearest abortion clinic. That’s crossing the line.”

The Missouri amendment’s sponsor, Rep. Robert Ross, R-Yukon, did not respond to a request for comment. However, he has said on the House floor that his provision is intended to eliminate any taxpayer support of abortions. Under federal law, Title X grants cannot be used to pay for abortion services.

CHICAGO (ChurchMilitant.com) - Pro-Life Action League protested Planned Parenthood's fundraising gala
Titled Generations Celebration held at the Sheraton Hotel in Chicago Wednesday evening April 26, 2017

Leading the protest was the group's executive director, Eric Scheidler, son of Joe Scheidler, who founded the Pro-Life Action League in 1980. Church Militant reached out to Eric Scheidler, who said showcasing the "horribly ironic title of the event" was one point they emphasized in their protest:

Planned Parenthood has been killing the next generation, starting with their first abortion in 1970 of a baby belonging to Generation X. They've aborted millions of Millennial children ... What's more, every time Planned Parenthood aborts a child, their cutting off a whole limb from the human family tree — all the generations of life that would have unfolded from that one life, cut short in the womb. And they pretend to “celebrate” our generations!

Some 200 sponsors of the abortion giant came out for the annual event. The gala raised money to abort this generation's children by having sponsors bid on "exciting silent auction packages," spin the trivia wheel and take part in a video to raise money for America's largest abortion provider. Some sponsors paid as much as \$100,000 to attend the event.

Scheidler said he was pleased with the 16 pro-lifers who turned out for the protest "at the end of the work day." He said they had no problem with police. "As usual, some members of the public objected to our presence with rude language and gestures, while others were pleased to see us and expressed their support," Scheidler observed.

Attack on Pro-Life Activist at an Abortion Facility Results in Capture of Child Rapist

April 14, 2017, seemed at first like just another routine day at the abortion clinic for a number of pro-life activists who spent the morning offering help to women and their companions as they reported to Reproductive Health Services, an abortion facility located on Perry Street in Montgomery, Alabama.

As one of the activists, Daniel French, approached one couple, the man became angry and threw his coffee on French and spit in his face.

The police were called to the scene where they arrested Logan Craft inside the abortion facility then marched him out to an awaiting police car. He was charged with Aggravated Assault and Harassment.

However, at least one the pro-life witnesses that day expressed further concern. Craft, a 24-year old Montgomery resident, had accompanied a girl that appeared to be underage. Just three days later on April 17, Craft was arrested again and charged on numerous charges related to sexual abuse of two minor girls less than 12 years old, according to a local news report. One of Craft's young victims had suffered abuse from April 10 through April 14 – the very day Craft took an apparently underaged young lady to the Reproductive Health Services abortion facility. Whether the abuse victim was the same person Craft was seen with at the abortion business remains unconfirmed at this time.

Planned Parenthood Doc Who Wanted Lamborghini for Selling Aborted Babies Caught Selling Baby Parts Again

Mary Gatter, the Planned Parenthood senior executive who infamously was caught on tape saying "I want a Lamborghini" while discussing and arranging the sale of body parts of aborted babies has been caught again.

As LifeNews reported in 2015, Mary Gatter, the Medical director at Planned Parenthood Pasadena and San Gabriel Valley in California, was caught selling aborted baby body parts to undercover investigators posing as officials with a biotech company that acts as a middleman to sell aborted baby body parts to universities and other places that conduct such research.

In the prior video, Gatter discusses the pricing of aborted baby body parts — telling the biotech company officials that the prices for such things as a baby's liver, head or heart are negotiable. She also tells the officials that she could talk with the Planned Parenthood abortion practitioners to potentially alter the abortion procedure to kill the baby in a way that would best pre-

serve those body parts after the unborn child is killed in the abortion.

In this new video, Gatter is again caught haggling over per-specimen pricing for livers, lungs, and brains, even while insisting the purchaser must do all the work to harvest.

Colorado Abortion Activists Celebrate 50 Years of Killing Babies in Abortion as First to Legalize It

Six years before Roe v. Wade, Colorado became the first state to legalize abortions widely up to 16 weeks of pregnancy.

The 50th anniversary of the deadly legislation was April 25, 2017, and abortion activists in the state are celebrating, according to the Associated Press.

Like most states at the time, Colorado protected unborn babies from abortions, except in cases of rape or incest, or when the mother's life was at risk. Republican state Rep. Richard Lamm's legislation changed that on April 25, 1967.

Described as "landmark" legislation at the time, the Colorado abortion law did not go as far as the U.S. Supreme Court decision Roe v. Wade did. It prohibited abortions after 16 weeks of pregnancy, and required a three-person board of doctors to unanimously approve the abortion. Abortions only were allowed to be performed in accredited hospitals, the report states.

"The bill passed a Republican-controlled Legislature with bipartisan support and was signed into law by Republican Gov. John Love despite strong objections from many constituents," according to the AP.

At the time, the news wire reported Love's office was flooded with about 5,000 letters and telegrams, the majority urging him to oppose the life-destroying bill.

"I am certain that the operation provided for will occur only in hospitals, subject to a severe test of accreditation, which will successfully prevent anything approaching abortion clinics," Love told the AP in 1967.

"The fear that some have that Colorado will become an 'abortion Mecca' if this bill becomes law does not seem to me well founded," Love continued.

Now, abortions are legal through all nine months of pregnancy in Colorado, and women do travel there to abort viable, late-term unborn babies at one of the last late-term abortion facilities in the country.

Virginia Beach Planned Parenthood Hospitalizes Second Woman in a Month

15th documented medical emergency at a Planned Parenthood abortion facility this year!

For the second time in the span of a month, the Planned Parenthood abortion facility in Virginia Beach, Virginia, has hospitalized another patient.

On April 7, 2017, an ambulance was called to Planned Parenthood for a 22-year old who was bleeding so severely that she needed emergency hospital care. Pro-life supporters snapped photos as an African American woman was wheeled out the Planned Parenthood's back door and into an awaiting ambulance.
